PeaceHealth Laboratories will be closing April 30

PeaceHealth Laboratories announced on Feb. 15, 2017, the sale of its outpatient laboratory testing program to Quest Diagnostics. The deal is expected to close on May 1, 2017. After that date, PeaceHealth Laboratories will no longer provide outpatient laboratory testing services, with the exception of the following locations: Cottage Grove Community Medical Center, Peace Harbor Medical Center, United General Medical Center, Peace Island Medical Center and Ketchikan Medical Center.

- The last day PeaceHealth Laboratories will accept specimens for testing is Sunday, April 30.
- The last courier pickup will be your last regular pickup for the week ending April 30.
- Any tests received prior to May 1 will be performed and resulted by PeaceHealth Laboratories.
- If you have questions about testing performed PRIOR to May 1, please continue to contact Client Services at 800-826-3616.
- If you have an interface with PeaceHealth Laboratories:
 - The inbound order interface will be turned off at midnight April 30.
 - The outbound result interface will remain on until all pending orders have resulted and notification is provided to PeaceHealth IST to it turn off.
- Keep your lock boxes. They will be used by Quest.
- Do not return any unused supplies. They may be used or disposed of at your discretion.
- Billing will follow normal processes.
- Please review test menu options with your new laboratory provider. We will no longer provide any direct outpatient laboratory services.
